Literacy

- **Reading**
 - Learning Intentions: We are identifying the beginning, middle and end in a plot.
 - Read one of the reading books sent home with a grown up, talk about the beginning, middle or end of the story.
 - Can you tell an adult about the plot of one of your favourite books? For example, Goldilocks, Little Red Riding Hood or Three Billy Goats Gruff.
 - Learning Intention: We are learning to identify nouns (naming words) and verbs (doing words) in our stories.
 - With an adult, point out nouns and verbs from your reading book.
- **Writing**
 - Learning Intention: We are learning to write stories with a beginning, middle and end
 - Write a story about an adventure on your time off school.
 - Learning Intention: We are learning to improve our stories by using WOW words and adjectives.
 - Write a story using WOW words to describe a character or place.
- **Phonics/Spelling**
 - Learning Intention: We are learning to use phonics to help us spell and read
