### Literacy

#### • Reading

- Learning Intentions: We are learning to explain why we prefer certain texts and authors.
  - Keep a small record of each book you read: the title, author and why you liked/disliked it.
  - Read a book and tell a grown up about your favourite part.
  - Read a book at home and tell a grown up about the main part of the story.
- Learning Intentions: We are learning to use expression and tone when reading aloud.
  - Read a story aloud to a grown up or family member and practise using expression.

- Write some silly sentences and practise reading them with different expressions: happy, sad, excited, scared, confident, etc.
- **Writing**
  - Learning Intention: We are learning to write news reports.
    - Pretend to be a journalist! Write a news report about an adventure on your time off school or base your report on a well-known fairy-tale.
  - Learning Intention: We are learning to improve our stories by using WOW words and adjectives.
    - Write a story using WOW words to describe a character or place.
- **Phonics/Spelling**
  - Learning Intention: We are learning to use phonics to help us spell and read.
