



**09.06.2020 HT's Daily Update – School Reopening Update and Carers' Week activities**

Good morning everyone.

I hope you are well and had a positive day yesterday.

Just a quick update this morning as, like many of you, I have another busy day ahead of me.

Firstly, I wanted to let you know that your Senior Leadership Team are working extremely hard to pull together elements of our Adaption and Renewal Plan for the school reopening in August. This includes finalising the staffing for next session.

We are still waiting for the information to come from Waverley Court which I hope will come out later this week. In the meantime, there are a few things we can do in preparation.

You may see one of our fabulous parents in the playground this week painting the markers to show the children where to line up.

Some of the staff will have access to the school building next week when we will be creating the signage, setting up the one-way system and organising the classrooms ready for the children's return.

We have had clear guidance from the Council that we will not be able to have any transition events in the school before the Summer, so the Senior Leadership Team are putting plans in place to create virtual tours.

Another job is to create the Adaption and Renewal Risk assessment, which will be done in collaboration with the Senior Leadership Team, our Business manager, staff members and representatives from our Parent Council. I am in discussions with people about being part of this working group and the timeline for this.

I hope this gives you some clarity as to what we are able to work on just now whilst waiting for the final decision to be made about the model of blended learning for Edinburgh schools.
